Chains Interrupted is a group of people whose hearts have been broken by the heinous evil of Human Trafficking. As many as 98%-99% of people effected by Human Trafficking never get out of "the life". For that reason, prevention education is central to what we do. We provide survivor advocacy working alongside those on their path to healing and restoration. Our collaborative efforts are guided by survivor input and include a local community coalition and community partnerships with law enforcement, medical professionals, the legal community and direct support providers to build a community wide action plan.

Human Trafficking is the fastest growing organized criminal industry in the world, now second only to drug trafficking. We need our whole community to join in the fight against this growing and heinous crime.
